#### **Prospects for 2021:**

With regard to renewal of our members from 2020, we were sadly notified during 2020 that five members (including one honorary member and one life member) had died, and that one member wished to resign before 2020.

As of mid-February 2021, 164 members of all types have already renewed their memberships (not including the 18 honorary and life members), as have 47 institutional subscribers; we have 8 new Britain/Ireland members so far in 2021 (including two students – one Britain/Ireland and one Rest of World, one junior member and one Rest of World member).
