In 2022 we had 236 members of all types (detailed below) and 57 subscribers to the Journal. Of these, 19 were new members (including one family membership, one junior member, one Rest of World member, and four student members) and 2 were new subscribers.

Prospects for 2023:

With regard to renewal of our members from 2022, we were sadly notified during 2022 that two members (including one honorary member) had died, and that four members (including two family memberships) wished to resign before 2023. No institutions have informed us that they intend not to renew for 2023.

As of late February 2023, 154 members of all types have already renewed their memberships (not including the 15 honorary and life members), as have 48 institutional subscribers; we have 7 new UK/Ireland members so far in 2023.
